Dear Parent or Guardian:

The purpose of this letter is to provide information concerning the Punahou JROTC Cadet Leadership Challenge (JCLC) Camp scheduled for June 2-5, 2019 at Bellows Air Force Station (AFS).

This four day, three-night encampment encourages teamwork, discipline, and camaraderie amongst students from different high schools, including homeschoolers. Cadets will be required to bring their own tent or arrange to share a tent with another camper. Cadets will receive one catered meal and two Meals, Ready to Eat (MRE's) daily. Cadets will also be given a catered bento lunch before pick up on June 5. All meals, transportation, costs for bowling, and a camp t-shirt are included in the \$150 camp fee.

To enroll, please fill out and mail or return the following forms to Punahou JROTC: Cadet Information Statement, State of Physical Condition, Covenant Not to Sue, Consent to Medical Treatment, and Self Administration of Medication (if applicable) along with \$150 payment (checks made payable to "Punahou School") by May 10, 2019. Students with certain medical conditions may not be allowed to participate in this camp without a doctor's consent. Please speak to an instructor if you have any questions. **A mandatory camp meeting for all cadets who have not previously participated in JCLC will occur on Friday, May 10 from 4 to 5 pm in the JROTC Classroom located on the middle level of the Asa Thurston PE Center at Punahou.** Uniforms and camp equipment will be issued following the meeting (plan on an additional 30 minutes).

Cadets are reminded this camp is an extension of the school campus and they will be expected to behave appropriately in accordance with school policy. Chaperones/instructors will be present on site twenty-four hours daily. Cell phones are authorized to be carried by cadets but should be safeguarded and weather proofed. All clothing and items should be packed in waterproof containers/bags. Expect everything to get wet and soiled with red dirt.

Cadets will report, wearing issued Army Camouflage Uniform, tennis shoes and carrying their dufflebag and boots to the bus stop located along Punahou School Palm Drive (lower part of campus, by the baseball field) no later than 9 am on June 2 to catch the bus to Bellows.
